ITEMS ARE SOLD WITHOUT ANY WARRANTIES WHATSOEVER, EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED, AND SPECIFICALLY THERE IS NO WARRANTY OR MERCHANTABILITY AND NO WARRANTY OF FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. Through all description and commentary are believed to be correct, on no event shall Auctioneer or seller be held responsible for having made or implied any warranty of description, genuineness, condition, etc. The property is open to thorough public inspection and making a bid is an acknowledgment that each bidder has had ample opportunity to, and has inspected the property. Once an item is sold and recorded on the clerk sheet, that item is the sole responsibility of the successful bidder. 3) Responsibility: All risk of loss and responsibility for purchase passes to successful bidder immediately upon reward of bid.
